The Shelby County Commissioners met on Monday March 3, 2025, at 8:00 a.m., and present were Commissioners Abel, Lawson, Runnebohm, County Attorney and County Auditor.

MINUTES:

Motion to approve February 24, 2025, was made by Lawson, seconded by Runnebohm, approved 3-0.

SHELBY CO. FAIR ASSOCIATION – REQUEST FOR FUNDS:

Christa Carson-Weaver with the Shelby County Fair Association is requesting two fundings.

1. Christa advised they have outgrown their cattle barn, and they are needing to re-wire the whole barn and expand in the front. They are requesting \$20,000.00 from the Commissioners to help with this project. Weaver advised she knows the Commissioners just helped with the pin barn.
2. Weaver advised the Commissioners donated \$9,000.00 every year for ribbons and judges, and have given that amount every year since she doesn't know when, but cost have gone up and advised the cost now is \$16,000.00 to \$17,000.00 and was wondering if the Commissioners could up that donation amount.

Commissioner Abel advised they would like time to discuss this and look into it what they currently pay and from what funds. No action was taken.
