ARI REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY MEMBERSHIP:

Carroll Rd, along Bassett Road, along E Michigan Rd near the intersection of Thompson Rd ending near 250 S. Motion to approve was made by Lawson, seconded by Runnebohm, approved 3-0.
