

The Shelby County Commissioners met on Monday October 30, 2023, at 8:00 a.m., present were Commissioners Nigh, Parker, Abel, County Attorney and County Auditor.

MINUTES:

ALS 360 STRYKER AMBULANCE EQUIPMENT LEASE:

Commissioner Parker presented the Commissioners with the Ambulance Equipment Lease. Commissioner Parker asked Commissioner Abel to explain the lease a little. Commissioner Abel advised this lease will be a 10-year lease and will allow our ambulances to replace equipment under this lease instead of paying outright for it. If the County receives a new ambulance, we will be able to equip the new ambulance without buying it individually. The total cost of the lease is \$2,776,190.00 for 10 years. The county's portion will be \$138,809.00 per year with the city paying the exact amount as the county per year. Motion to approve was made by Abel, seconded by Nigh, approved 3-0.
