The Shelby County Commissioners met on Monday March 17, 2025, at 8:00 a.m., and present were Commissioners Lawson, Runnebohm, County Attorney and County Auditor.

MINUTES:

Motion to approve March 10, 2025, was made by Lawson, seconded by Runnebohm, approved 2-0.

ATTORNEY GENERAL OFFICE/ PARKER FLETCHER:

Parker Fletcher with the State Attorney Office wanted to come and speak to Shelby County about all of the Unclaimed Property that the State has that is due to the residence of the State. Fletcher advised there are billions of dollars that the state is holding on to. If you go to the Attorney Generals web page there is a QR Code you can click on, and it will take you to the page to see if you have money coming back to you from the state. There are many steps, and you have to prove that you are that person, and there is a phone number there for customer service and they can help you also. This was information only; no action was needed.

UTILITY REQUEST:

Duke Energy is requesting to replace three poles near 6597 S 250 E, Waldron, motion to approve was made by Lawson, seconded by Runnebohm, approved 2-0.

Kuhn Transport Inc. Is requesting a road cut on 500 N 2200' West of State Road 9 for a field tile. Motion to approve was made by Lawson, seconded by Runnebohm, approved 2-0.

HIGHWAY:

Ben Taylor advised they were out for most of the day Saturday clearing roads and helping other public safety workers from all of storm damage. This was information only.

Ben presented the Commissioners with the CCMG 2025-1 Agreements with the state for bridges 128 & 146. They need approval so that Jason can go in and electronically sign the contract. Motion to approve was made by Runnebohm, seconded by Lawson, approved 2-0.

Mike Oberfell with USI presented the Commissioners with an Authorization to proceed form for the CCMG 2025-2 project. This is for the pavement of 500 S going into Waldron. This is not to exceed \$44,000.00. Motion to approve was made by Lawson, seconded by Runnebohm, approved 2-0.

Ben advised that the INDOT would be closing South State Road 9 between 750 S & 850 S starting March 24, 2025, for a culvert replacement. They will also be closing North State Road 9 between 750 N & 850 N on April 14, 2025, they will both be for 18 days. This was information only.

Ben advised the county will have 800 E between Michigan Road and St. Paul City limits to get the road paved while school is out for Spring Break. They will also have 350W closed between 200 N and 100 N to replace a culvert. This was information only.
