#### **WALDRON CONSERVANCY GRANT PROCESS:**

Kylie Sparks & Jill Curry with SIRPC to hold the public meeting for the Waldron Conservancy Grant Application. They explained this grant is for upgrades to the Water Treatment Plant. At this time, they opened the floor for any questions or comments. The Commissioners had a few questions and comments. How much will this effect the current water bills? They advised they are hoping to keep a 4,000-gal monthly bill from \$34.92 to between \$66.62 - \$77.21 a month. This would be with the OCRA Grant and would help cover future needs. One good thing is the Conservancy currently has PVC pipe in so that is good, they are needing to replace tanks and equipment at the treatment plant. Motion to approve the Letters of Support and application disclosure form for the project was made by Lawson, seconded by Runnebohm, approved 3-0.

#### **SPEEDWAY SOLAR UPDATE:**

Danny Norris with Speedway Solar wanted the Commissioners know they ran the bidding process for the road construction and received 5 letters of interest and they have picked the contractor for the job. They are hoping to kick things off with a Memorandum of Understanding on Thursday and start on October 20, 2025. Jeff Powell asked Norris if there were aware that they need to leave the Section Corner Stones in the roadways. Norris advised they were aware of that and would make sure they are left. Total road miles will be approximately 15. Norris also wanted to let Desiree know that he will be getting the new plans for landscaping to her this week. This was information only; no action was needed.
