The Shelby County Commissioners met on Monday, November 17, 2025, at 8:00 a.m., and present were Commissioners Abel, Lawson (Zoom), Runnebohm, and County Auditor.

MINUTES:

PLAN COMMISSION / ADA CONTRACT RENEWAL:
