

The Shelby County Commissioners met on Tuesday January 20, 2026, at 8:00 a.m., present were Commissioners Abel, Lawson, Runnebohm, County Attorney and County Auditor.

MINUTES:

Motion to approve January 12, 2026, minutes was made by Lawson, seconded by Runnebohm, approved 3-0.

BIDS FOR BRIDGE #22 REPLACEMENT:

The Commissioners received the following bids:

After review from Mike Obgerfell his recommendation is the low bid in the amount of \$1,102,893.85 to Duncan Robertson, motion to approve was made by Lawson, seconded by Runnebohm, approved 3-0.


Bridges of Shelby County


HIS Contractors was awarded this project in the spring of 2025.
