MINUTES:

Motion to approve March 16, 2026, minutes was made by Lawson, seconded by Runnebohm, approved 3-0.

PROBATION / OFFICE CLOSURE & GRANT SUBMISSION:

Alison is requesting to close the office on May 13, 2026, from 12-4 for training. She advised this training was originally scheduled for February, but the instructor had the flu. Motion to approve was made by Lawson, seconded by Runnebohm, approved 3-0.

Alison is also requesting approval to submit their DOC yearly grant. With this grant the Probation Office will receive \$123,020.00 that pays for one fulltime Probation Officers and Community Corrections will receive \$420,234.00 which pays for all salaries in Community Corrections.
