

The Shelby County Commissioners met on Monday, April 6, 2026, at 8:00 a.m., present were Commissioners Abel, Lawson, Runnebohm, and County Auditor.

MINUTES:

Motion to approve March 30, 2026, minutes was made by Lawson, seconded by Runnebohm, approved 3-0.

AMERICAN LEGAL PUBLISHING AGREEMENT:

The Commissioners presented an Agreement with American Legal Publishing in the amount of \$10,500.00 over 2 years and then \$695.00 each year after. This company will help get the County Ordinances and Resolutions uploaded for public viewing. They will also help go through current Ordinances and Resolutions already in place and suggest other Ordinances and Resolutions they feel the county should have in place. Motion to approve was made by Lawson, seconded by Runnebohm, approved 3-0.

HWC ENGINEERING: GATEWAY PROJECT APPLICATION:

Commissioner Runnebohm explained that part of the READI Grant that the State has, there is a big portion of grant money for Artwork in the different districts that are a part of the READI grant. The READI Grant Committee has decided to put in for this portion to hopefully be able to put new infrastructure to the I-74 corridor from Pleasant View down to Greensburg. Runnebohm advised the applications are due by April 15, 2026, and they should know something at the end of June or beginning of July. Motion to approve was made by Runnebohm, seconded by Lawson, approved 3-0.

SIRPC – WALDRON CONSERVANCY:

SIRPC is requesting the Commissioner to sign a request to release funds and Certification for the Waldron Conservancy District's project in the amount of \$750,000.00. Shelby County is a bypass between the State and Waldron Conservancy. Motion to approve was made by Lawson, seconded by Runnebohm, approved 3-0.

The Commissioners are also requested to sign the Environmental Assessment Factor form. Abel advised this is an OCRA Assessment Form needed for the Grant. Motion to approve was made by Lawson, seconded by Runnebohm, approved 3-0.
