

The Shelby County Commissioners met on Monday, April 27, 2026, at 8:00 a.m., present were Commissioners Abel, Lawson, John DePrez (Attorney) and County Auditor.

MINUTES:

Motion to approve April 20, 2026, minutes was made by Lawson, seconded by Abel, approved 2-0.

SHELBY SENIOR SERVICES / 1QTR INVOICE & 2027 GRANT :

Easter Hall-Beyer presented the Commissioners with the 1st Qtr. 2026 Invoice and the 2027 Pass-thru grant for approval. The invoice is for \$41,248.00. Motion to approve was made by Lawson, seconded by Abel, approved 2-0.

AMERICAN LEGION / AL CALHOUN:

Al Calhoun on behalf of the American Legion is requesting to be able to use the Courthouse lawn for the Memorial Day Program. Motion to approve was made by Lawson, seconded by Abel, approved 2-0.

MAINTENANCE DIRECTOR / ELEVATOR CONTRACTS:

Jose presented the Commissioners with two contracts for upgrades on the Courthouse elevators. Jose advised that the public elevator would cost \$124,335.25 and the inmate elevator would be \$146,055.25 for a total of \$270,390.50 and they need a deposit in the amount of \$148,714.78. Jose advised this had been presented to the Council last week and they approved the funding out of RACINO. Motion to approve was made by Lawson, seconded by Abel, approved 2-0.

DUKE ENERGY/ SCHEFFLER FARM:

Duke Energy is requesting to expand their easement on the Scheffler Farm from 25 feet to 100 feet, to purchase price of the easement is \$105,246.00. Abel asked to table for this week, to verify a couple things. Motion to table was made by Lawson, seconded by Abel, approved 2-0.

By having this program and the data it will produce could help with receiving grant money. It will take pictures of the roads every 10 feet.
