The Shelby County Commissioners met on Monday, May 4, 2026, at 8:00 a.m., and the present were Commissioners Abel, Lawson, Runnebohm, John DePrez (Attorney) and County Auditor.

MINUTES:

Motion to approve April 27, 2026, minutes was made by Lawson, seconded by Abel, approved 2-0-1 (Runnebohm).

PROCLAMATION FOR MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS MONTH :

At this time Commissioner Abel read the Proclamation for Mental Health Awareness Month. Motion to approve the Proclamation was made by Lawson, seconded by Runnebohm, approved 3-0.

UTILITY REQUEST:

QC COMMUNICATIONS/ RIGHT OF WAY PERMITS:

1. Installing new coaxial cable in pipe near 6564 N Michigan Rd. Motion to approve was made by Lawson, seconded by Runnebohm, approved 3-0.
2. Install new coaxial cable in pipe near 6924 W 200 N, Fountaintown. Motion to approve was made by Lawson, seconded by Runnebohm, approved 3-0.

BSM GROUPS/ RIGHT OF WAY PERMIT:

1. Request to bore duct and fiber optic cable along E 1100 N, along and under S 250 W, and under N 200 W, near 2785 W 1100 N, Fountaintown. Ben advised he was ok with this but said this needs to go through the drainage board and approved by them, because this goes thru a county ditch. Motion to approve pending the approval of the Drainage Board, was made by Lawson, seconded by Runnebohm, approved 3-0.

OPIOD SETTLEMENT RESOLUTION:
