

The Shelby County Commissioners met on Monday, June 29, 2026, at 8:00 a.m., and the present were Commissioners Abel, Lawson, Runnebohm, John DePrez (Attorney) and County Auditor.

MINUTES:

Motion to approve June 22, 2026, minutes was made by Lawson, seconded by Runnebohm, approved 3-0.

OPEN RFP'S FOR CORONER/MAINTENANCE BUILDING:

The Commissioners received 4 RFP'S for the Coroner/Maintenance Building and are excepting the following: BW Construction, First Due, Runnebohm, and Skender. Abel advised they would award the contract next week at their meeting.

BRADY CLAXTON / MCGOWAN INSURANCE GROUP:

Brady Claxton with McGowan Insurance presented the Commissioners with the renewal of both Property and Liability for the County. We made some changes to the policies, we increased it by 2,000,000.00 for the buildings, not so much cost but cost of replacement. This is with Chub and there was a 2 ½% increase. For Liability Insurance was added a full abuse & molestation for all departments instead of just a few select. We added 4 new vehicles, more Cyber protection. The total for both will be \$686,990.00. Motion to approve was made by Lawson, seconded by Runnebohm, approved 3-0.
