

The Shelby County Commissioners met on Monday, July 27, 2026, at 8:00 a.m., and the present were Commissioners Abel, Lawson, Runnebohm, John DePrez (Attorney) and County Auditor.

MINUTES:

Motion to approve July 20, 2026, minutes was made by Lawson, seconded by Runnebohm, approved 3-0.

FACILITIES DIRECTOR/ COURT HOUSE REPAIRS:

Jose advised he received 2 quotes for the repairs that need to be done for the exterior of the Courthouse and Circuit Court. First quote was from A & A Construction in the amount of \$155,958.00 and Runnebohm Construction in the amount of \$164,400.00. Motion to approve low bid was made by Lawson, seconded by Runnebohm, approved 3-0.

EMA / REQUEST TO CLOSE US 252/ FLAT ROCK FISH FRY:

Denis advised he found out some more information for the Flat Rock Fish Fry Parade. They are requesting to close down a portion of US 252 on August 15, 2026, from 1:00 to 1:30 for their annual parade. Ratekin advised the parade route will be South Main up to US 252 to Washington Street. There was discussion with concerns of the safety of people being on US 252. Ben Taylor advised they could do a detour from 300 W to 1200 S to 200 W and back up to US 252. Motion to approve was made by Lawson with stipulations that the detour route be clearly marked and EMA will put their sign boards.

UTILITY / ROAD CUT REQUEST:

1. BSM Groups is requesting to bore a fiber optic cable along 550 E near 8025 S 550 E, St. Paul. Motion to approve was made by Lawson, seconded by Runnebohm, approved 3-0.
2. Smooth Stone Excavating LLC is requesting to do a road cut on 375 W approximately 450' north of 9840 S 375 W. This is a 10" tile and Taylor is requesting this be bored because of the road being repaved with in the last 5 years. Motion to approve boring only was made by Runnebohm, seconded by Lawson, approved 3-0.
3. AT&T is requesting to bore fiber optic cable along 800 N, 875W & Brookfield Street, motion to approve was made by Lawson, seconded by Runnebohm, approved 3-0.
