

ORDINANCE NO. 2025- 18

WHEREAS, the Shelby County Commissioners do receive permit applications for utility companies to perform work within the County right-of-way.

WHEREAS, the Shelby County Highway Department expends time and manpower to review and investigate all right-of-way work applications.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF SHELBY, as follows:


Anyone submitting a permit application to the Shelby County Commissioners to perform work within the County right-of-way shall be required to remit the following fees:


- Application Fee - \$100
- Pedestals - \$100 each
- Handholes - \$25 each
- Tap pit - \$75 each
- Boring under roadway - \$75
- Placement of Poles: New Location - \$150 each
- Boring, trenching, grading or excavation parallel to roadway - \$100/400 Ft.


Additional fees may be calculated after plan review by the Shelby County Highway Department and if so calculated, shall be paid by the applicant. The fees are to offset the time and manpower expended by the Shelby County Highway Department in the review and investigation of the right-of-way work applications. Additionally, an application fee may be doubled if work in the County right-of-way takes place prior to submitting and paying for a permit and/or prior to permit authorization (except for authorized emergency work in which case a permit shall still be submitted and paid for after emergency work is done).
